Meeting Opened:

Grand Knights Report

- Jim Scott reported, - No rosary or Corporate Communion (conflict with Lent),. Discussion of next scheduled rosary for 2026Q2, matter to be taken up at future meeting.

Treasurer

- Treasurer Jerry Mosier, \$8108.36 in checking; Checks written: \$58.34 for per capita; RSVP and Food for Families (refund applications in the works), \$903 in food basket account.

For the benefit of new Brothers, Jerry presented information on the Council's food basket program. Occurs in December, Super 1 has donated dry goods, Councils assembles 2 boxes per HH, individuals needing assistance, also individuals in retirement centers. In Dec, Council contacts our member churches to get their names recommended for the list, St. Anthony and St. Mathew, Longview, St. Teresa of the Infant Child Jesus, Gladewater and St. Francis of Assisi, Gilmer. KCs take the food boxes to the churches, which distribute them to the families on their lists. In 2025, 750 boxes were donated to 300+ families, totaling \$13,000 in value. The Council has been distributing Christmas boxes since the 1960s.
